Conditions of Entry	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• All exhibits must be delivered upon arrival to the Steward.• Exhibitors must state on the entry form the number of cattle stalls/ pens required.• Multiple entries will be accepted in all classes.• All exhibits must be the bona fide property of the exhibitor.• The age of cattle will be taken as from the 1st day of August, 2023.• All cattle must carry an NLIS device and owners are responsible for transferring/recording of the animals.• All exhibitors and grooms must sign a Wee Waa Show Society waiver form.• Grooms must remain in attendance until completion of judging.• Cattle must remain on the grounds until 4.30pm on Saturday.• Under no circumstances may an exhibit leave the yards or stall without a Steward having delivered the beast to the Exhibitor.• Junior events held after stud cattle judging. Junior cattle judging class for under 12 will be ran if there are enough numbers.• The 2023 Wee Waa Show Junior Parading Competition will see the introduction of the ASC recommendation that only steers and heifers be used in this competition. Led bulls will no longer be used in Junior Parading Competitions by paraders' under 19 years of age from 2020.• Attire is neat dress and closed in boots. Any enquiries can be made to stewards.• There will be Bovine Pestivirus Certification requirements for exhibits for the 2022 Wee Waa Show. 2022 Wee Waa Show will be a No Bovine Pestivirus Show for ALL STUD AND COMMERCIAL CATTLE and all cattle will need proof of Negative Status for entry as per ASC Recommendations from 2015.• PIC Number: #NC452061
