Conditions of Entry	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Fleeces must not exceed 12 months growth and must be skirted.• Fleece bags/cartons must be labelled with Owner’s Name and their respective Class Numbers.• Wool must be from Unhoused and Un-rugged Sheep with the exception of Class 12.• No pet Fleeces, with the exception of Class 13.• Separate Fleeces must be provided for each entry, as each Fleece will be accepted for one Class only with the exception of Class 15.• All Fleeces must be the property of and grown by the Exhibitor.• The judge has the right to reclassify any exhibit.• Any fleece not collected by 5:00 pm will be considered donated unless prior arrangements are made.• Entry Form must be signed by Exhibitor.• It is the responsibility of memorial trophy recipients to organise the engraving and payment for engraving of trophy

MERINO PREMIUM SHORN WOOL

Fleeces from growers shearing in 6-9 month cycles as commercial practise. Dates of current and previous shearing to be stated by exhibitor. Fleece weights divided by weeks growth then multiplied by 52 for top and nail. Ewe and wether only. May come from sheep bred or purchased by exhibitor. Breeder and bloodlines may be stated.
