Conditions of Entry

- If a Trophy is awarded there will be no first prize money awarded.
- All exhibits must be the original work of the Exhibitor, except for Class 1.
- Limit of two (2) entries per class per Exhibitor.
- Exhibits must have attached to the back of them - Name of the Exhibitor, Section & Class Number.
- The right is reserved to alter any class entered by the exhibitor or create additional classes.
- Exhibits to be entered in one class only.
- Standard must reach the judge's criteria for an award to be made.
- Exhibits to be in as new or unwashed condition.

NOTE: Handicraft entries are eligible for the Maisie Hibbens " Most Successful Exhibitor" trophy. Sections are awarded on the following point score basis: 1st: 3 points, 2nd: 2 points, 3rd: 1 point. Maximum points for any one section are 25 points.
