<b>Conditions of Entry</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● Exhibits must be the bona fide works of the exhibitor and must not have been awarded a 1st prize at any previous Wee Waa Show.</li><li>● Exhibits must be clean and must be delivered to the show office or to the stewards no later than 5:00 pm, Wednesday the 23rd of August.</li><li>● Exhibits must be clearly marked with exhibitor's name, section and class number.</li><li>● The Society will take due care of all exhibits, but no responsibility can be accepted for damage to or loss of any item.</li><li>● All exhibits will be judged on overall appearance.</li><li>● Exhibits and trophies may be collected from the stewards on Sunday the 27th of August between 10:00 am and 12:00 pm at the showground. A signature may be required.</li><li>● Exhibits may be moved to another more appropriate class after agreement between stewards and judges.</li><li>● The judge’s decision will be final.</li><li>● It is the responsibility of memorial trophy recipients to organise the engraving and payment for engraving of trophy</li></ul>
